Pursuant to the Council on Environmental Quality regulations for implementing the National Environmental Policy Act and 32 CFR Part 651, *Environmental Analysis of Army Actions*, the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP) announces the availability of an Environmental Assessment (EA) and Draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the siting, construction, and operation of a Rail Transload Facility at the IAAAP in Middletown, Iowa. Based on the EA, the Army believes that the proposed action with its reliance on avoidance and minimization measures would not have significant direct, indirect, or cumulative impacts on the quality of the human or natural environment, and therefore, proposes to issue a FONSI. Copies of the EA, Draft FONSI, and supporting documentation are available for review at the Burlington Public Library, 210 Court Street, Burlington, Iowa 52601 for thirty days following the date of publication of this Notice of Availability.
